## Resolution Number 2020-1

WHEREAS the City of Beaverton's major Street's Fund has a \$73,543 deficit fund balance, the Hydroelectric Fund has a deficit unrestricted net position of \$273,318 and the Sewer Fund has a deficit unrestricted fund balance of \$81,281 on June 30, 2019; and

WHEREAS 1971 PA 140 requires that a Deficit Elimination Plan be formulated by the local unit of government and filed with the Michigan Department of Treasury;

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS RESOLVED that the City of Beaverton's Council adopts the following as the City of Beaverton's Deficit Elimination Plan:
