## **Resident Seasonal Watering Program**

### **2023 Opt-In Form**

The City of Beaverton is once again offering the Seasonal Watering Program for all residents that Opt-In to the Program by July 10, 2023. If you currently water your lawns more than normal or have a large garden to maintain, the city recognizes that you should not be billed for the sewer portion of the additional water you use while watering your yard/garden. The city will analyze your May/June and July/August billing cycles and compare them to your average bi-monthly bills for the last two years and if there is a noted increase in water consumption in those months, the Treasurer will adjust the sewer portion of the extra water billing manually from those two billing cycles. **You MUST BE Opted-In to the Program by July 10<sup>th</sup>, 2023** in order to have a billing review.
